

**ROBERT BROWNING, JR.**  
**PAST INTERNATIONAL DIRECTOR**

Robert "Bob" Browning, Jr., of Pineville, West Virginia, USA, was elected to serve a two-year term as a director of The International Association of Lions Clubs at the association's 79th International Convention, held in Montreal, Quebec, Canada, July 9-12, 1996.

Past Director Browning is a lawyer.

A Life Member of the Pineville Lions Club, Past Director Browning has held many offices within the association, including club president, zone chairman, district governor and council chairman. He also served as district youth exchange chairman, multiple district leadership development chairman and as Trustee of the West Virginia Lions Sight Conservation Foundation.

In recognition of his service to the association, Past Director Browning has received numerous awards, including the 100% District Governor Award, the Membership Advancement Key Award, an Extension Award, an International President's Certificate of Appreciation, three International President's Awards and an Ambassador of Good Will Award (the highest honor granted by the association to its members). In addition to his Lion activities, Past Director Browning is involved in many civic and professional organizations. He is a member of Bar Associations at the local, state and national levels; serves as the Wyoming County Mental Hygiene Commissioner and the City Attorney for Pineville and Oceana; trustee of the Wyoming County Library Commission; is both an Elder and Trustee in his church; and has been a director of the People's Bank of Mullens since 1985.
